3. Product Description

The patented Flipit Safety Line Block is a unique combination of safety and effectiveness when using line blocks and corner poles to build masonry walls. The Flipit Line Block hooks securely on the Flipit Corner Pole, virtually eliminating the possibility of line blocks disconnecting from the corner poles. Line blocks are under an extreme amount of tension on the corner pole. When they disconnect, or "fly off", workers can be seriously injured. The Flipit Line Block gives masons peace of mind when working with line blocks and corner poles. Additionally, lines that fly off cost the mason wasted time resetting the line. The Flipit Line Block and Corner Pole combine to provide a safer, more productive work environment.

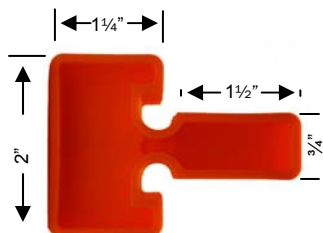
Additionally, the building of quoins is a breeze with the Flipit Safety Line Block. The Flipit Line Block allows the mason to simply "flip" the Flipit block around, utilizing either the inside or outside offset projection of the body of the Flipit. Masons can charge a premium for the building of quoins, without spending any additional labor—paying for the set of blocks and poles on the very first job. With the Flipit, building quoins is as simple as a flip of the wrist, and can be done without ever moving the pole!

The FLIPIT is also beneficial when building with split-face block. The Flipit allows for the extra depth of split-face block and eliminates the problem of the corner pole interfering with the uneven face of the block.

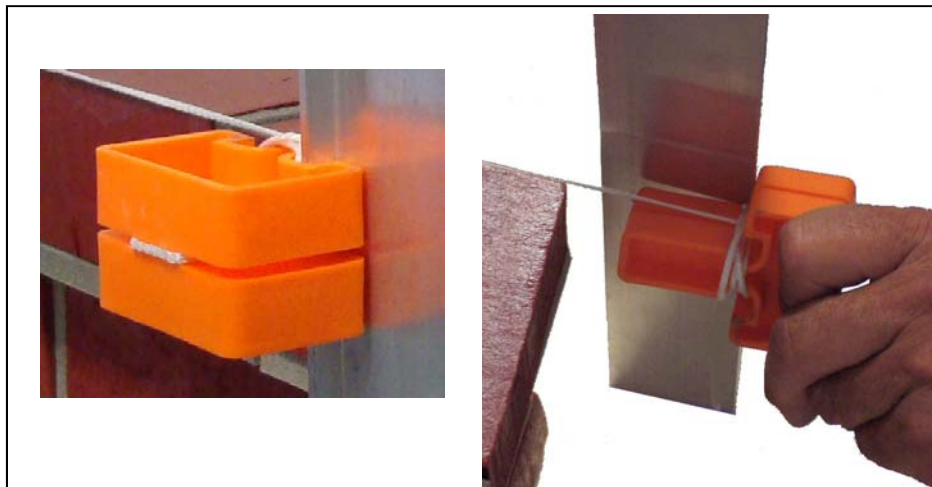

5. Installation

Flipit Safety Line Blocks and Corner Poles are used in the same manner as standard line blocks and corner poles, utilizing the same line and connecting brackets as standard poles. For building quoins, simply flip the Flipit Safety Line Block (as shown above) to utilize the interior or exterior offset of the Flipit Safety Line Block (as shown at right).

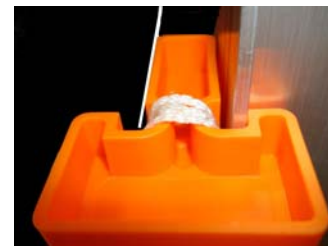

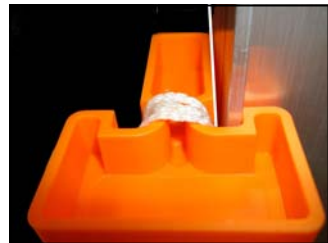
