3. Product Description

The IPCOTE Hot-Dip Galvanized Anchor Bolt addresses the higher copper content preservatives being used to treat lumber, such as ACQ (aluminum chromated quat) or CA (copper azole). The IPCOTE Hot Dip Galvanized Anchor Bolt exceeds the ASTM A-153 standard for zinc coating that is recommended for use with these preservatives. The bolts are post-batch hot-dipped to insure that all areas of the bolt are protected.

The IPCOTE Hot-Dip Galvanized Anchor Bolt is a unique anchor bolt design which has been used successfully for over 40 years. The bolts fit in the head joint of the concrete block, setting securely between the blocks rather than in the core. The IPCOTE HDG bolt will not turn, twist or pull loose, and will always set straight for easy fitting of the sill plate.

IPCOTE HDG Anchor Bolts save time by eliminating the labor used in filling the cores and setting the round bolts, as well as time spent straightening crooked bolts. Because they fit in the head joints, the bolts will always be evenly spaced and the correct height.

IPCOTE HDG Anchor Bolts are available in two configurations—single course anchorage or double course anchorage. Installation of the bolts is fast and easy and is done as the wall is being constructed, again saving time and labor spent installing standard round bolts. The bolts are supplied with oversized hot-dip galvanized nuts and washers to insure zinc coated protection for the entire anchor bolt assembly.

The multitude of sizes and dimensions available for the IPCOTE HDG Anchor Bolts allow the bolts to fit almost any wall configuration and size requirement.
